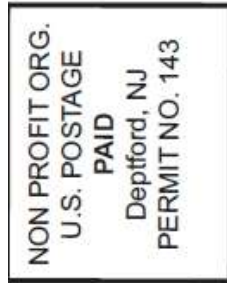

Tall Pines State Preserve

In 2015 Tall Pines became Gloucester County's first state preserve. Once a popular golf course, Tall Pines is 110 acres of grasslands, woodlands, small ponds and freshwater wetlands in Deptford and Mantua Townships, just south of the Borough of Wenonah. Mantua Creek flows through its center. The preserve is home to an unusually rich and diverse number of bird species. Tall Pines is a great place for people to hike, jog, bird watch, cycle and experience the beauty of nature.
